Public Notice No. 02/2011 dated. 24.10.2011

All Exporters/CHAs, traders and others are hereby informed that in terms of Notification No. 97/2009-Customs dated 11.09.2009 as amended by Notification No. 51/2011 dated 22.06.2011, the Duty Entitlement Pass Book Scheme has been withdrawn w.e.f 30.09.2011. As a trade facilitation measure, it has been decided that upon cessation of the DEPB Scheme, there is no need to seek individual amendment in the existing Letter of Factory Stuffing Permission (LoFSP) granted for Factory Stuffing of containers under DEPB Scheme and the exporters may continue to use the same permission for export under any of the export promotion schemes of their choice and eligibility, without seeking any amendment in LoFSP held by them.

2. All Manufacturers/Merchant Exporters holding valid LoFSPs issued by this office and who have opted for DEPB Scheme for export of their factory stuffed containers, are hereby informed that upon cessation of the DEPB Scheme they may continue to export under an alternate export scheme of their choice and eligibility on the basis of same LoFSP. There is no need to seek individual amendment in their LoFSP by approaching this office.
3. Free Shipping Bills will continue to be governed by the guidelines of Self Sealing as per Board's instruction vide Circular No. 860/18/2007-CX dated 22.11.2007.
4. In case of any difficulty, jurisdictional AC/DC may be contacted immediately.
